An athlete to compete in the Lovelock Classic shall be aged 15 years or over on the 31st December 2022 and have achieved the required senior, junior or youth standard in the event they wish to compete.

Late registrations will only be accepted at the Control Room on the day, closing at 11.30am, and only if there is space available in the event. Late entries **will incur a late registration fee of \$20.00** on top of Registration Fee and Event Entry Fee.

Field Events are Open Grades, throwing implements will be the Senior weights.

Track Events

- **Sprint Events** will have an A, B or C Grade, season's best times must be given on registering.
- **Long Distance** – all age grades will compete together.
- **Lovelock Mile** – seeding applies – A Grade maximum of 16 entrants then B grade race

If using own implements for throwing, implements must be calibrated by 12 noon, they will then go into the pool of implements to be used.

Athletes must sign in at Registration / Control Room on arrival, to collect their Competition Number, and programme.

All Athletes must wear either correct Club Uniform or Sponsorship Gear, no civvies to be competed in.

Prize Money will be paid directly into the winners Bank Account – please supply bank account details to the Control Room if you are a recipient of a prize.
